- You may choose another verse not listed below, but it must be approved by Peter Hiller. The verse must express one of "God's Promises" to us.

Psalm 23:1	The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not be in want.
Psalm 46:1	God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble.
Psalm 55:22	Cast your cares on the Lord and he will sustain you; he will never let the righteous fall.
Psalm 73:23-24	Yet I am always with you; you hold me by my right hand. You guide me with your counsel, and afterward you will take me into glory.
Psalm 89:1-2	I will sing of the Lord's great love forever; with my mouth I will make your faithfulness known through all generations. I will declare that your love stands firm forever, that you established your faithfulness in heaven itself.
Psalm 91:1-2	He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress; my God, in whom I trust."
Psalm 139:9-10	If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea, even there your hand will guide me, your right hand will hold me fast.
Proverbs 30:5	Every word of God is flawless; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him.
Isaiah 40:31	Those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.
Jeremiah 29:11	"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "Plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you a hope and a future."
Joshua 1:9	Be strong and courageous. Do not be terrified; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go.
Matthew 6:33	But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.
Matthew 28:20b	And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.
Luke 11:28	"Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it."

Romans 15:13	May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.
I Corinthians 6:20	You were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your body.
II Corinthians 9:8	And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.
Ephesians 2:8-9	For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith---this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God---not by works, so that no one can boast.
Ephesians 3:20	Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us,
Philippians 4:19	And my God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus.
Hebrews 13:5b	Be content with what you have, because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."
I Peter 1:3	Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,
Revelation 2:10	Be faithful, even to the point of death, and I will give you the crown of life.
