Registrations after January 15 will be accepted based on availability.

**Cancellations:** All deposits are refundable before Jan. 15, 2012. After January 15, refunds are available minus any expense incurred for the spot and if a replacement participant is available.

### Adult Leaders:

Adult counselors are needed for the trips. Adults must be at least 21 years old and complete background check. Leaders are accepted through an application process. Please see Youth Ministry Staff for an application.

### Fundraising:

Several fundraisers are planned for those students who want to raise money necessary to attend a summer event. Fundraisers include Christmas Wreath Sale, Super Sub Sale, and Spring Plant Sale. Fundraising is optional. You may also find Sponsors for your trip. Sponsorship forms are available from the Youth Ministry office upon request.

### Scholarships:
